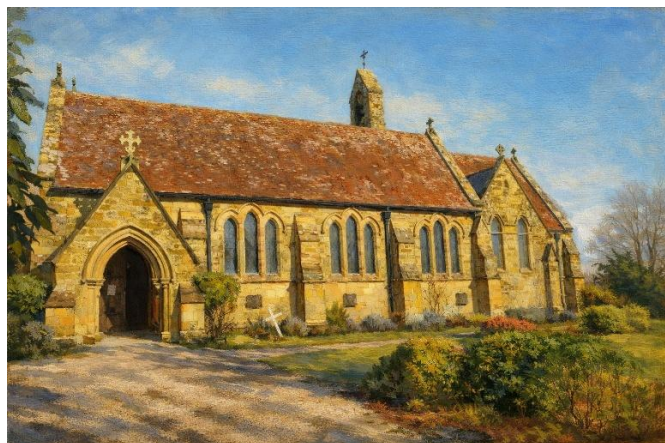

The Mother's Union was the idea of a vicar's wife, Mary Sumner who set up a young wives group, who met once a month. That was a humble beginning to what has become a worldwide organisation today. We continue to help communities change their lives, by working to combat poverty, injustice and violence, especially in hard to reach places.

A branch first met here in Langton Green in 1926, and, although now a very small group we still meet once a month and contribute if we can to any projects the Mothers Union are supporting. We collect toiletries for the women's refuge and support AFIA, which is 'Away from it all' which provides holidays for underprivileged families.

To celebrate our 100th birthday we are holding a small tea party in June.

Hopefully this great organisation will continue to serve the world.
