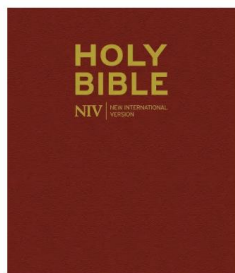
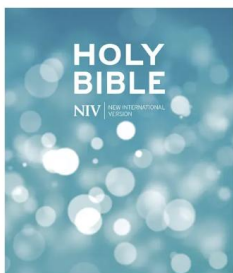
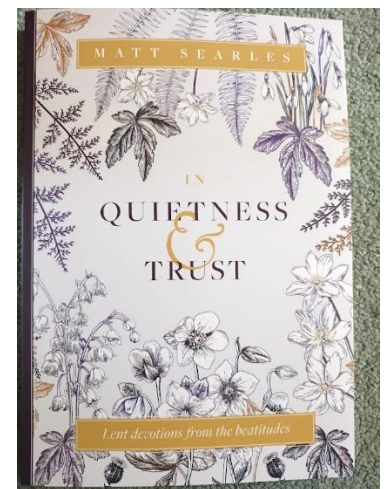
January 2026 Newsletter

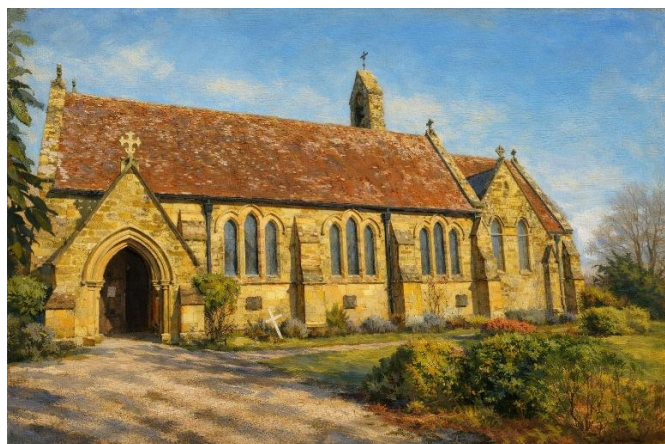
